ORDINANCE NO. 2012-0006

BOARD OF REVIEW MEMBERSHIP

WHEREAS, under Section 70.46 (1) of the Wisconsin Statutes the membership of the Town's Board of Review:

The Town Board of Cassian, Oneida County, Wisconsin, by this ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, ordain as follows:

The Supervisors and Clerk shall constitute the Board of Review for the Town. The Town Clerk shall be the clerk of the Board of Review and shall keep an accurate record of all its proceedings. In addition, alternate members may be appointed and may serve as follows: Alternate members shall be Town residents and may include public officers and public employees. Alternate members shall be appointed on/or after the 3rd Tuesday in April of odd numbered years, by the Town Chairperson, subject to the confirmation of the Town Board, for a term of two years, provided that initially three alternate members shall be appointed for a term of one year. This appointment shall be for the effective period beginning with the approval of this ordinance and ending on the 3rd Tuesday in April, 2013. At the time of their appointment, each alternate members shall be designated either as first, second, or third alternate, to establish the priority of all alternate members, and this priority may be revised annually by the Town Chairperson subject to the confirmation of the Town Board. The first alternate member shall act with full power when one member is absent, refuses, or is otherwise unavailable to hear an objection. The second alternate member shall act with full power when two members (or one member and the first alternate member) are absent, refuse, or are otherwise unavailable to hear an objection. The third alternate member shall act with full power when three members (or two members and the first or second alternate member, or one member and the first and second alternate member) are absent, refuse, or are otherwise unavailable to hear an objection. The members and alternate members of the Board, except those who are full-time officials of the Town, may receive such compensation as shall be fixed by resolution of the Town Board.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and posting or publication as required under s. 60.80 Wis. stats.:
